Dublin, Georgia is located 145 miles SE of Atlanta; 120 miles W of Savannah, 50 miles from Macon and 100 miles from Augusta on U.S. 80 and 441 just off I-16. From Atlanta and Macon (I-16) Exit #42, Hwy 338 to Dudley, then E on U.S. 80 to Dublin Mall. From Savannah use Exit #51. Follow US 441 N then left at Industrial Blvd. (Big Flag), follow Industrial Blvd. N and turn right at Walke Dairy Road, follow Walke Dairy Road (which becomes Mall Road) to Shamrock Drive; then turn right to Dublin High School (which will be on your left).
